

3D-HUNTING BOW-COURSE & SHOOTING RANGE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (GTC)

The use of the 3D-archery-course and the shooting range „Erlebniswald Altenmarkt“ of FEHU GmbH is allowed for the following participants and under the following conditions:

1. Determination: entry requirements

- 1.1 Children and young people are only allowed to use the course when accompanied by an adult (over 18 years of age). By signing the general terms and conditions, she assumes full responsibility for the children and young people she accompanies.
- 1.2 The 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and the Shooting Range may only be entered if you have properly registered, read and signed the terms and conditions and paid the entry fee.
- 1.3 It is forbidden to shoot at the 3D-targets and targets with broadheads, a compound bow or a crossbow.
- 1.4 The course may only be shot at during the opening times.

2. Determination: liability for rental equipment and your own material

- 2.1 The participants are liable for the rental items and must return them in perfect condition.
- 2.2 Damaged or lost items will be charged:
 - 2.2.1 Damage or loss of an arrow will be charged at Euro 4,-.
 - 2.2.2 Damage or loss of a bow will be charged at Euro 150,-.
 - 2.2.3 There are no claims for compensation for lost or damaged arrows, bows, etc. that you brought with you.

3. Determination: access authorization

- 3.1 No beginner is allowed to attempt the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course or the Shooting Range without the instruction of a trained shooter or the staff of „Erlebniswald Altenmarkt“. It is only permitted to use the course if an instruction course has been successfully completed.

4. Rules for using bows and arrows

- 4.1 Before shooting, every archer must ensure that the field of fire is clear both in front of and behind the target. If there is even the slightest doubt, stop immediately. Each shooter is solely and fully responsible for the arrow she shoots and for any damage or injuries to people that may arise as a result. For minors point 1.1. applies.
- 4.2 The bow may only be drawn or shot with the arrow in the target direction. The archer must pay particular attention to ensuring that all accompanying persons and other archers stand behind her when drawing the bow and firing it.
- 4.3 You may only shoot at the 3D-targets and targets that have been set up.
- 4.4 Shooting at live animals or undesignated targets is prohibited.
- 4.5 Failure to comply with the rules will result in the immediate withdrawal of shooting privileges and expulsion from the course area.

5. Rules in the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and the Shooting Range

- 5.1 It is expressly forbidden to leave the marked paths or bypass barriers.
- 5.2 The 3D-Hunting Bow-Course area can only be walked in the direction marked by the ascending numbers of the targets. Reversing is not permitted (one-way rule). If you want to end the course round earlier, you are obliged to follow the course path in the specified direction until the end of the course.
- 5.3 It is forbidden to change the 3D-targets or the shooting pegs yourself.
- 5.4 It is prohibited to shoot more than two arrows per 3D-target per round. The arrows must be drawn in such a way that the targets are neither damaged nor displaced.
- 5.5 If arrows are sought, care must be taken to ensure that subsequent shooters also notice this. In such a case, a fellow shooter must stand clearly in front of the 3D-target, or it must be clearly marked with a bow, a piece of clothing or something similar leaning against it.
- 5.6 The course area is marked with warning signs for other people. If, contrary to expectations, people or animals stray beyond the targets, please contact them and point them to the marked and safe hiking trails or drive away animals. Under no circumstances may the archer fire a shot at a target if another person or animal is in the field of vision or in the scatter cone.
- 5.7 **IMPORTANT:** If an archer notices misconduct or safety-endangering non-compliance with the course rules in the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course or the Shooting Range by another archer, this must be reported to the staff immediately for safety reasons.

6. Exclusion from use

- 6.1 Persons who do not comply with the access regulations are excluded from using the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and the Shooting Range.
- 6.2 Access is not permitted to persons under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs.
- 6.3 If the rules are not adhered to, the staff is permitted to exclude people from using the facilities.

7. Liability

- 7.1 Use of the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and the Shooting Range is at your own risk.
- 7.2 Accompanying persons are liable for the safety of children and young people under the age of 18.
- 7.3 FEHU GmbH assumes no liability for damage or soiling to clothing or lost items.
- 7.4 The FEHU GmbH is liable for personal injury and property damage within the scope of legal provisions.

8. Entrance and rental fee

- 8.1 The prices of FEHU GmbH include the legally required VAT.
- 8.2 The prices stated by FEHU GmbH at the time the contract is concluded apply to the use of the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and the Shooting Range

9. Refund of the entrance and rental fee

- 9.1 There is no entitlement to a refund if participants leave the facility early at their own request or if the participant is excluded from use due to non-compliance with the general terms and conditions.
- 9.2 Cancellation due to a change in the weather is not refundable.
- 9.3 The staff is authorized to stop operating the 3D-Hunting Bow-Course and Shooting Range for safety reasons.
